

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2878/80
of 6 November 1980
repealing Regulation (EEC) No 2786/80 authorizing intervention buying-in of
sheepmeat in France

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
1837/80 of 27 June 1980 on the common organiza-
tion of the market in sheepmeat and goatmeat⁽¹⁾,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No
2755/80 of 28 October 1980 on the conditions for
implementing and suspending intervention buying-in
of sheepmeat⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 1 (4) thereof,

Whereas it has been found that the conditions laid
down in Article 7 (2) and (4) of Regulation (EEC) No
1837/80 were not fulfilled during the week
commencing 20 October 1980 in France ;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No
2786/80⁽³⁾ was adopted on the basis of the erroneous
finding that the conditions cited above had been
fulfilled ; whereas the said Regulation should therefore
be repealed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 2786/80 is hereby repealed with
effect from 3 November 1980.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
