ANNEX V

INSTRUCTIONS TO MASTERS REQUIRED TO KEEP A LOG-BOOK AS SHOWN IN ANNEX II AND A LANDING/TRANSHIPMENT DECLARATION AS AT ANNEX III

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE LOG-BOOK AND THE LANDING/TRANSHIPMENT DECLARATION
 - 4.1. Procedure for completion
 - 4.1.1. Entries in the log-book and on the landing/transshipment declaration shall be legible and indelible.
 - 4.1.2. No entry in the log-book or on the landing/transshipment declaration may be erased or altered. If a mistake is made, the incorrect entry shall be struck out with a line and followed by a new entry initialled by the master or his agent.
 - 4.1.3. At least one landing declaration should be completed per vessel. One transshipment declaration should be completed for each transshipment operation.
 - 4.1.4. Each page of the log-book shall be signed by the master. The landing declaration shall be signed by the master or his agent.
