Parental responsibility

Article 13

Jurisdiction based on the child's presence

- Where a child's habitual residence cannot be established and jurisdiction cannot be determined on the basis of Article 12, the courts of the Member State where the child is present shall have jurisdiction.
- 2 Paragraph 1 shall also apply to refugee children or children internationally displaced because of disturbances occurring in their country.
