## ANNEX I

Specific migration limit for BADGE and certain of its derivatives

- 1. The sum of the migrations of the following substances:
- (a) BADGE [= 2,2-bis(4-hydroxyphenyl)propane bis(2,3-epoxypropyl) ether] (CAS No = 001675-54-3)
- (b) BADGE.H<sub>2</sub>O (CAS No = 076002-91-0)
- (c) BADGE.2H<sub>2</sub>O (CAS No = 005581-32-8)

shall not exceed the following limits:

- 9 mg/kg in food or food simulants, or
- 9 mg/6 dm<sup>2</sup> in accordance with the cases provided by Article 7 of Commission Directive  $2002/72/EC^{(1)}$ .
