#### CHAPTER 2

#### **Restrictions process**

#### *[<sup>X1</sup> Article 73*

#### **[<sup>F1</sup>Restriction decisions]**

1 If the conditions laid down in Article 68 are fulfilled, the [<sup>F2</sup>Secretary of State must propose] a draft amendment to Annex XVII, within three months of receipt of [<sup>F3</sup>the Agency's opinions]. [<sup>F4</sup>The functions of deciding whether to propose a draft amendment, and of proposing a draft amendment, are subject to the consent requirement in Article 4A.]

Where the draft amendment diverges from the original proposal or if it does not take the opinions from the Agency into account, the [<sup>F5</sup>Secretary of State] shall annex a detailed explanation of the reasons for the differences.

[<sup>F62</sup> The Secretary of State may, by regulations, amend Annex 17 to include the draft amendment.

Regulations under this paragraph are to be made by statutory instrument; and a statutory instrument containing regulations made under this paragraph is subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.

The function of making regulations under this Article is subject to the consent requirement in Article 4A.]]
