Commission Regulation (EC) No 1506/2007 of 18 December 2007 on the issuing of import licences for applications lodged during the first seven days of December 2007 under tariff quotas opened by Regulation (EC) No 539/2007 for certain products in the egg sector and for egg albumin

Article 1

- 1 The quantities for which import licence applications have been lodged pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 539/2007 for the subperiod 1 January to 31 March 2008 shall be multiplied by the allocation coefficients set out in the Annex to this Regulation.
- The quantities for which import licence applications have not been lodged pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 539/2007, to be added to the subperiod 1 April to 30 June 2008, are set out in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 19 December 2007.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
