

Commission Regulation (EC) No 589/2008 of 23 June 2008  
laying down detailed rules for implementing Council Regulation  
(EC) No 1234/2007 as regards marketing standards for eggs

*Article 6*

**Time limit for grading, marking and packing eggs and marking packs**

- 1 Eggs shall be graded, marked and packed within 10 days of laying.
- 2 Eggs marketed in accordance with Article 14 shall be graded, marked and packed within four days of laying.
- 3 The date of minimum durability referred to in Article 12(1)(d) shall be marked at the time of packing in accordance with <sup>F1</sup>Annex 10 to Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011].
