Release for free circulation

Release for free circulation for the quotas of CXL concession sugar with order numbers 09.4317, 09.4318, 09.4319, 09.4321, 09.4329 and 09.4330 shall be subject to the presentation of a certificate of origin issued by the competent authorities of the third country concerned in accordance with Articles 55 to 65 of Regulation (EEC) No 2454/93.

For CXL concession sugar with order numbers 09.4317, 09.4318, 09.4319, 09.4320, 09.4329 and 09.4330, where the polarimetric reading of the imported raw sugar departs from 96 degrees, the rate of, respectively, EUR 98, EUR 11 and EUR 54 per tonne shall be increased or reduced, as appropriate, by 0,14 % per tenth of a degree difference established.]
