

Commission Regulation (EU) No 1266/2010 of 22  
December 2010 amending Directive 2007/68/EC as regards  
labelling requirements for wines (Text with EEA relevance)

*Article 1*

In Article 3 of Directive 2007/68/EC the third paragraph is replaced by the following:

Member States shall allow wines, as defined in Annex XIb to Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007, placed on the market or labelled before 30 June 2012, and which comply with the provisions of Directive 2005/26/EC, to be marketed until stocks are exhausted.
