# F1... List of authorised substances

- Only the substances included in the  $^{F2}$ ... list of authorised substances (hereinafter referred to as the  $^{F2}$ ... list) set out in Annex I may be intentionally used in the manufacture of plastic layers in plastic materials and articles.
- The F2... list shall contain:
  - a monomers or other starting substances;
  - b additives excluding colorants;
  - c polymer production aids excluding solvents;
  - d macromolecules obtained from microbial fermentation.
