CHAPTER II

COMPOSITIONAL AND INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

SECTION I

General requirements

Article 6

General provisions

- 1 Food referred to in Article 1(1) shall comply with any requirement of [^{F1}retained EU law] applicable to food.
- 2 The requirements laid down in this Regulation shall prevail over any conflicting requirement of [^{F1}retained EU law] applicable to food.
