CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 2

Scope

2 This Regulation does not apply to the provision of trust services that are used exclusively within closed systems [^{F2}by operation of law] or from agreements between a defined set of participants.

3 This Regulation does not affect [^{F3}the] law related to the conclusion and validity of contracts or other legal or procedural obligations relating to form.
