CHAPTER VIII

Remedies, liability and penalties

Article 77

Right to lodge a complaint with [^{F1}the Commissioner]

1 Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, every data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with [^{F2}the Commissioner] if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes this Regulation.

2 [^{F3}The Commissioner] shall inform the complainant on the progress and the outcome of the complaint including the possibility of a judicial remedy pursuant to Article 78.
