## COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2019/1347

of 8 August 2019

**approving non-minor amendments to the specification for a name entered in the register of protected designations of origin and protected geographical indications ('Roquefort' (PDO))**

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1151/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 November 2012 on quality schemes for agricultural products and foodstuffs <sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article 52(2) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) By virtue of the first subparagraph of Article 53(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1151/2012, the Commission has examined France's application for the approval of amendments to the specification for the protected designation of origin 'Roquefort', registered under Commission Regulation (EC) No 1107/96 <sup>(2)</sup>, as amended by Commission Regulations (EC) No 828/2003 <sup>(3)</sup> and (EC) No 938/2008 <sup>(4)</sup>.
- (2) Since the amendments in question are not minor within the meaning of Article 53(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1151/2012, the Commission published the amendment application in the *Official Journal of the European Union* <sup>(5)</sup> as required by Article 50(2)(a) of that Regulation.
- (3) As no statement of opposition under Article 51 of Regulation (EU) No 1151/2012 has been received by the Commission, the amendments to the specification should be approved,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The amendments to the specification published in the *Official Journal of the European Union* regarding the name 'Roquefort' (PDO) are hereby approved.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
