
Status: This is the revised version from EUR-Lex dated 01/03/2020. This treaty has changed its name over time, originally signed in Rome in 1957 as the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community (The Treaty of Rome) then becoming Treaty establishing the European Community. PART SEVEN

GENERAL AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 336

(ex Article 283 TEC)

The European Parliament and the Council shall, [^{X1}acting by means of regulations in accordance with the ordinary legislative procedure and after] consulting the other institutions concerned, lay down the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union and the Conditions of Employment of other servants of the Union.
