

Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act (Northern Ireland) 2011

2011 CHAPTER 23

An Act to make provision for the gating of certain minor roads; to make provision in relation to vehicles parked on roads that are exposed for sale or being repaired; to make provision in relation to abandoned vehicles and the removal and disposal of vehicles; to make provision in relation to litter and graffiti, fly-posting and the display of advertisements; to make provision relating to the control of dogs; to make provision in relation to noise; to restate the law on statutory nuisances and improve the summary procedures for dealing with them; to increase the maximum penalty in relation to certain pollution offences; and for connected purposes. BE IT ENACTED by being passed by the Northern Ireland Assembly and assented to by Her Majesty as follows:
