Schedule 2: Articles 63B to 63R of the Police and Criminal Evidence (Northern Ireland) Order 1989, as inserted

Article 63F – Retention of material: persons convicted of a recordable offence

This Article provides that a person's fingerprints or DNA profile may be retained indefinitely if convicted of a recordable offence (Article 63F(2)) except where a person under the age of 18 years at the time of the offence is convicted of a nonqualifying offence and has no previous convictions. In such a case the retention periods in new Article 63H will apply (Article 63F(3)).
