### SCHEDULE 4

#### PRIVATE SEXUAL PHOTOGRAPHS ETC: PROVIDERS OF INFORMATION SOCIETY SERVICES

##### *Interpretation*

- 4.—(1) This paragraph applies for the purposes of this Schedule.
- (2) “Photograph or film” has the meaning given in [F1section 52].
- [F2(3) “Information society service” means any service normally provided—
- (a) for remuneration,
  - (b) at a distance (namely, the service is provided without the parties being simultaneously present),
  - (c) by electronic means (namely, the service is—
    - (i) sent initially and received at its destination by means of electronic equipment for the processing (including digital compression) and storage of data, and
    - (ii) entirely transmitted, conveyed and received by wire, radio, optical means or other electromagnetic means), and
  - (d) at the individual request of a recipient of services (namely, the service is provided through the transmission of data on individual request).]

(4) “Recipient”, in relation to a service, means a person who, for professional ends or otherwise, uses an information society service, in particular for the purposes of seeking information or making it accessible.

(5) “Service provider” means a person providing an information society service.
