Appeals

Appeals against a fixed monetary penalty

- 11.—(1) A person on whom a fixed monetary penalty has been imposed may appeal against the decision to impose it on the grounds specified in paragraph (2).
 - (2) The grounds for appeal are—
 - (a) that the decision is based on an error in fact;
 - (b) that the decision is based on an error in law;
 - (c) that the decision was unreasonable; and
 - (d) any other reason permitted by the Appeals Commission.
