The Appropriation (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1974

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made 18th December 1974

Coming into Operation 25th December 1974

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of December 1974

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 (a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on the seventh day after the day on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (b) shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Issue of sum out of Consolidated Fund for service of year ending 31st March 1975

3. There shall be charged on and issued out of the Consolidated Fund, and the Department of Finance may apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending 31st March 1975 the sum of thirty-one million, eight hundred and fifty thousand, six hundred pounds.

Power for Department of Finance to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole sixteen million pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1975.

Appropriation of grants

5.—(1) The sum authorised to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund as mentioned in Article 3 is hereby appropriated for the several services and purposes expressed in the Schedule.

(2) In addition to the sum authorised to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund as mentioned in Article 3, the sums, which under the Appropriation (Northern Ireland) Order 1974 (a), were authorised to be applied as appropriations in aid for the year ending 31st March 1975, shall be treated as having been increased or, as the case may be, decreased by the sums respectively set forth in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule.

Amendment of the Appropriation (Northern Ireland) Order 1974

6. In Schedule (B) to the Appropriation (Northern Ireland) Order 1974, in Part II, Class IV, No. 5 shall have effect and be deemed always to have had effect as if for the figures "24,151,400" in column 2 there were substituted the figures "24,141,400".
