#### Members

**6.**—(1) The Head of the Department may at any time remove a person from office as chairman[<sup>F1</sup>, deputy chairman] or member of the[<sup>F1</sup> Executive] if satisfied that—

- (a) he has been absent from meetings of the[<sup>F1</sup> Executive] for a period longer than six consecutive months without the permission of the[<sup>F1</sup> Executive]; or
- (b) he has been convicted of a criminal offence; or
- (c) he has become bankrupt [<sup>F2</sup>or is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order] or made an arrangement with his creditors; or
- (d) he is incapacitated by physical or mental illness; or
- (e) he is otherwise unable or unfit to perform his duties.

(2) If the chairman[<sup>F1</sup> or deputy chairman] ceases to be a member of the[<sup>F1</sup> Executive] he shall also cease to be chairman[<sup>F1</sup> or, as the case may be, deputy chairman].
