- **6.**—(1) The Head of the Department may at any time remove a person from office as chairman[^{F1}, deputy chairman] or member of the[^{F1} Executive] if satisfied that—
 - (a) he has been absent from meetings of the [F1 Executive] for a period longer than six consecutive months without the permission of the [F1 Executive]; or
 - (b) he has been convicted of a criminal offence; or
 - (c) he has become bankrupt [F2 or is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order] [F3 or a debt relief order has been made in respect of him or he is the subject of a debt relief restrictions order] or made an arrangement with his creditors; or
 - (d) he is incapacitated by physical or mental illness; or
 - (e) he is otherwise unable or unfit to perform his duties.
- (2) If the chairman[F1 or deputy chairman] ceases to be a member of the[F1 Executive] he shall also cease to be chairman[F1 or, as the case may be, deputy chairman].
