#### FUNCTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT IN RELATION TO SLAUGHTER

##### PART I

##### POWER TO SLAUGHTER

**Sheep-pox:**

- 6.—(1) The Department shall cause to be slaughtered all sheep affected with sheep-pox.
- (2) The Department may cause to be slaughtered—
  - (a) any sheep suspected of being affected with sheep-pox; and
  - (b) any sheep which are or have been in contact with sheep affected with sheep-pox or which appear to the Department to have been in any way exposed to the infection of sheep-pox.
