PART VIII GENERAL

Enforcement of byelaws

- **31.**—(1) The Department or, as the case may be, the Secretary of State, may authorise persons appointed or employed to enforce byelaws made under Articles 19, ^{F1}... and 30 and to take all steps and do all acts and things, necessary for that purpose.
- (2) In particular, any person authorised under paragraph (1) may, after due warning, remove or exclude a person from any land to which a byelaw made under Article 19, ^{F1}... or 30 applies who commits, or whom he reasonably suspects of committing, an offence against any such byelaw.
 - (3) A person who—
 - (a) commits an offence against any byelaw made under Article 19, F1... or 30; or
 - (b) obstructs any person authorised under paragraph (1);

shall be guilty of an offence under this Order, and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
