## Title and commencement N.I.

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Still-Birth (Definition) (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1992.

# Interpretation N.I.

- **2.** The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>FI</sup> shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

## Meaning of "still-birth" N.I.

- **3.** In Article 2(2) of the Births and Deaths Registration (Northern Ireland) Order 1976<sup>F2</sup> (interpretation), in the definition of "still-birth", for the words "twenty-eighth week" there shall be substituted the words "twenty-fourth week".

# Meaning of "confinement" for certain social security purposes N.I.

- 4. In the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992<sup>F3</sup>
  - (a) in section 35(6) (definition of "confinement" for the purpose of maternity allowance), and
  - (b) in section 167(1) (interpretation of Part XII-statutory maternity pay), in the definition of "confinement",

for the words "28 weeks" there shall be substituted the words "24 weeks".
