#### THE NORTHERN IRELAND TOURIST BOARD

#### Membership

[F13.—(1) The Board shall consist of—

- (a) a chairman, and
- (b) not more than 8 other members, appointed by the Minister of Enterprise, Trade and Investment ("the Minister").
- (2) Appointments under sub-paragraph (1) shall be made from among persons who appear to the Minister to have experience in any field of activity which the Minister considers is relevant to the discharge of the functions of the Board.
- (3) The Minister may appoint one or more of the members appointed under sub-paragraph (1) (b) as a deputy chairman.]

- (4) Where a member becomes or ceases to be the chairman or a deputy chairman of the Board, the Head of the Department may vary the terms of his appointment.
- (5) A person shall, on ceasing to hold office as a member of the Board, be eligible for re# appointment.
