Other restrictions in interests of safety

## Drunkenness, etc., in charge of horse-drawn vehicle

- **40.**—(1) A person who when driving, attempting to drive or in charge of, a vehicle drawn by a horse or other animal on a road or other public place, is unfit to drive through drink or drugs (that is to say, is under the influence of drink or a drug to such extent as to be incapable of having proper control of the vehicle), is guilty of an offence.
- (2) Any person liable to be charged with an offence under this Article shall not be liable to be charged under Article 10(2) of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1980<sup>F1</sup> (being drunk while in charge in a road or other public place of an animal).
