Representations other than by a person

- **33.**—(1) Where a representation of any fact—
 - (a) is made otherwise than by a person, but
- (b) depends for its accuracy on information supplied (directly or indirectly) by a person, the representation is not admissible in criminal proceedings as evidence of the fact unless it is proved that the information was accurate.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not affect the operation of the presumption that a mechanical device has been properly set or calibrated.
