The Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005

Penalty charges

Duty to cancel notice

11.—(1) Where the [^{F1}enforcement authority] accepts that a ground mentioned in Article 9(2) has been established, it shall—

- (a) cancel the notice served under Article 6 or 7; and
- (b) state in the notice served under Article 9(4)(b) that the notice served under Article 6 or 7 has been cancelled.

(2) The cancellation of a notice under paragraph (1) does not prevent the [^{F1}enforcement authority] from serving a fresh notice on another person (to which, in the case of a notice under Article 7, paragraph (2) of that Article shall not apply).

(3) Where the [^{F1}enforcement authority] accepts that the ground mentioned in Article 9(2)(d) has been established, the person hiring the vehicle shall be taken to be its owner for the purposes of this Order.
