# The Sexual Offences (Northern Ireland) Order 2008

### PART 3

#### SEXUAL OFFENCES AGAINST CHILDREN

#### Assault

#### Causing or inciting a child under 13 to engage in sexual activity

- 15.—(1) A person commits an offence if—
  - (a) he intentionally causes or incites another person (B) to engage in an activity,
  - (b) the activity is sexual, and
  - (c) B is under 13.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under this Article, if the activity caused or incited involved—
  - (a) penetration of B's anus or vagina,
  - (b) penetration of B's mouth with a person's penis,
  - (c) penetration of a person's anus or vagina with a part of B's body or by B with anything else, or
  - (d) penetration of a person's mouth with B's penis,
- is liable, on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for life.
  - (3) Unless paragraph (2) applies, a person guilty of an offence under this Article is liable—
    - (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum or both;
    - (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 14 years.
