PROTECTION OF DEPOSITORS

REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD MAY 1974, MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE UNDER SECTION 24 OF THE PROTECTION OF DEPOSITORS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 24(1) of the Protection of Depositors Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Protection of Depositors (Prescribed Documents) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on 6th May 1974.

2. The Protection of Depositors (Prescribed Documents) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations revoke the Protection of Depositors (Prescribed Documents) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964. The fee of 25p will no longer have to be paid to the Registrar of Companies for the registration of accounts, notices and documents delivered to him under the Protection of Depositors Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.
