Shipbuilding (Reports on Breathing Apparatus Etc.) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 1 1

1. 2. 1 Made 15th September 1975 Coming into operation . . 17th November 1975

The Department(a) of Manpower Services by virtue of section 176(1) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and in pursuance of regulation 50(3) of the Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), the powers under which are now vested in it(d), hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Shipbuilding (Reports on Breathing Apparatus Etc.) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 17th November 1975.

2. Reports on the results of examinations under regulation 50(3) of the Regulations of breathing apparatus, belts, ropes, lamps and torches shall contain the following particulars:

- (i) the name and address of the employer of the worker for whose use the equipment is provided;
- (ii) the date of the examination and by whom it was carried out;
- (iii) in the case of breathing apparatus, particulars of the type of apparatus, the name of the maker, and the distinguishing number or mark together with a description sufficient to identify the apparatus:
- (iv) in the case of belts, ropes, lamps and torches, the distinguishing number or mark and a description sufficient to identify each of them:
- (v) the condition of the breathing apparatus, belts, ropes, lamps and torches, particulars of any defects found at the examination, and of the steps taken to remedy such defects; and
- (vi) in the case of compressed oxygen apparatus or of a compressed air apparatus, the pressure of oxygen or of air, as the case may be, in the supply cylinder.
