WAGES COUNCILS

Shirtmaking Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), and now vested in it(b), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Shirtmaking Wages Council (Northern Ireland):

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Shirtmaking Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977.

Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means 3rd May 1977, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

SCHEDULE

Statutory Minimum Remuneration

The Shirtmaking Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(c) (Order N.I.S. (95)) shall have effect as if in the First Schedule thereto there was inserted after paragraph 7 a new paragraph as follows:—

Paragraph 7A

"ATTACK ON INFLATION-THE SECOND YEAR" SUPPLEMENT

(a) in addition to the remuneration specified elsewhere in this Schedule there shall be paid a further supplement entitled the "Attack on Inflation—The Second Year" as follows:—

_	a maximum of 40 hours per week
(i) workers to whom paragraphs 1, 3, 5 and 7(a) of this Schedule apply	p 6·25

- (ii) Workers to whom paragraphs 6 and 7(b) apply—the relevant percentage as expressed in paragraph 6 of 6.25p per hour up to and including a maximum of 40 hours per week.
- (b) The "Attack on Inflation" and the "Attack on Inflation—The Second Year" Supplements shall not be taken into account in calculating the overtime rates payable under paragraph 17 of this Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order comes into operation on 3rd May 1977.

The Schedule amends the Shirtmaking Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by that Order.

New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.
