## Statutory Rules Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977

The Department(a) of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4 of the Statutory Rules Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) and paragraphs 2(1) and (2) and 3(7) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the concurrence of the Lord Chief Justice, hereby makes the following regulations:

## Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Statutory Rules Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 16th May 1977.

#### Rule-making authority

2. The Registrar of Friendly Societies for Northern Ireland is hereby prescribed as a rule-making authority for the purposes of the Statutory Rules Act (Northern Ireland) 1958.
