**ELECTRICITY SUPPLY****Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979**

*Made* . . . . . 17th December 1979

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st March 1980

WHEREAS the Department(a) of Commerce (hereinafter called "the Department") being satisfied that Charles Elliott of Innisclin, Stragolan, Kesh, County Fermanagh desires to obtain a supply of electricity from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland for his premises at that address and the Northern Ireland Electricity Service has consented to that supply:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 31 of the Electricity Supply (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1980.

*Permission of Department*

2. The Department hereby grants permission to the said Charles Elliott to obtain from the Electricity Supply Board a supply of electricity for his premises at the aforesaid address.
