The Department(a) of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 97 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies (Credit Union Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

Revocation

2. The Industrial and Provident Societies (Credit Union Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(c) are hereby revoked.

Amendment of fees

3. For Schedule 2 to the Industrial and Provident Societies (Credit Unions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(d) (as substituted by the Industrial and Provident Societies (Credit Union Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979), there shall be substituted the following Schedule:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase by 40% the fees to be paid for matters transacted or arising under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 in relation to credit unions.

They supersede the Industrial and Provident Societies (Credit Union Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979.
