## EDUCATION

Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1983

Made . . . . . 5th July 1983

Coming into operation . . . . . 1st August 1983

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 105(1) and 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1983.

*Amendment of the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973*

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) for “£2,413”(d) there shall be substituted “£2,527”.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply where grant is in respect of salary which is payable in respect of any period before the coming into operation of these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations increase from £2,413 to £2,527 per annum the base figure used in the calculation of the annual rate of salary grant payable in respect of each recognised teacher appointed to the authorised staff of a voluntary grammar school by the school authorities with the approval of the Department of Education.

The increase does not apply to grant in respect of salary which is payable in respect of any period before the coming into operation of these regulations.
