The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 15 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Eel Fishing (Licence Duties) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1984.

### Licence duties

2. There shall be payable to the Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland by way of licence duties for the use of fishing engines for the taking of eels referred to in column 1 of the Schedule the amounts respectively specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

#### Revocation ·

3. The Eel Fishing (Licence Duties) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) are hereby revoked.
