JUDGMENTS (ENFORCEMENT)**Judgment Enforcement (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1985**

Made 19th June 1985
Coming into operation 22nd July 1985
To be laid before Parliament

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Articles 84(1)(b) and 141(1) of the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a), hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1985.

2. In Article 84(1)(b) of the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 for the figure “£400” (size of debt by virtue of which a person scheduled to an administration order is entitled to present, or join in, a bankruptcy petition against a debtor without the leave of the Office) there shall be substituted the figure “£1,500”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules increase from £400 to £1,500 the figure specified in Article 84(1)(b) of the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981. That Article specifies the figure which a debt must exceed if it is to enable a person scheduled to an administration order to present, or join in, a bankruptcy petition against a debtor without the leave of the Enforcement of Judgments Office.
