**Police Cadets (Amendment No. 2) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1985**

Made 18th December 1985

Coming into operation 1st February 1986

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 10 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and after taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing that Board with a draft of the regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and effect

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st February 1986 and shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 3 as from 1st September 1985.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980(d).

Pay

3. For the Table in Schedule 2 to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following Table:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Police Cadets Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980.

Regulation 3 increases the pay of cadets from 1st September 1985.

Regulation 4 increases the annual charge payable by cadets for board and lodging provided by the Police Authority with effect from 1st February 1986.

Retrospective effect for regulation 3 is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.

Medicines (Labelling) and (Leaflets for Veterinary Drugs) (Amendment)

These Regulations have been made by the Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 85(1)(2), 86(1) and 91(3) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act these Regulations have been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. They are printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1985 and have been numbered 2008 in that series.
