Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 28th November 1988

Coming into operation 1st January 1989

To be laid before Parliament

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 22 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and now vested in him(b) hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Deduction from Taxed Costs) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1989.

2. Paragraphs 1(1) and 2(1) of Schedule 2 to the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 shall be amended by substituting for the percentages "ninety per cent." the percentages "ninety-five per cent."

These Regulations reduce from 10 per cent. to 5 per cent. the deduction which, by virtue of paragraphs 1(1) and 2(1) of Schedule 2 to the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981, is to be made from the remuneration of counsel and solicitors under Part II of that Order in connection with proceedings in the House of Lords, the Court of Appeal and the High Court.
