Colleges of Education Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988

4th March 1988 Made Coming into operation 31st March 1988

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 69(1) and (4) and 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Colleges of Education Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1988 and shall have effect:—
 - (a) for the purpose of regulation 3 on and from 1st October 1987;
 - (b) for the purposes of regulations 4 to 6 on and from 1st April 1987;
 - (c) for the purposes of regulations 7 to 12 on and from 1st September 1987:
 - (d) for the purpose of regulation 13 on and from 1st April 1988;
 - (e) for the purposes of regulations 14 to 17 on and from 1st July 1988.

Amendment of Colleges of Education Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981

- 2. The Colleges of Education Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(c) are hereby amended in accordance with the following provisions of these regulations.
- 3. In regulation 3(2) after "allowance" there shall be inserted "other than promotion allowance as defined in the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987"(d).

AMENDMENTS HAVING EFFECT ON AND FROM 1ST APRIL 1987

Allowances

- **4.**—(1) In regulation 10(1) and (2) (allowances for head of department) for "£1,509" and "£1,326" there shall be substituted respectively "£1,584" and "£1,392".
- (2) In regulation 11 (allowances for principal lecturers) for "31st March 1985", "5.5%" and "1st April 1986" there shall be substituted respectively "31st March 1987", "5%" and "1st April 1987".

Salary scales

5. In paragraphs 1, 7 and 8 of Schedule I for the existing tables of salary scales there shall be substituted the respective tables of salary scales set out in Annex A of this amendment.

Entry to salary scales

6. In Schedule II (Entry to Scales of Salaries) for "31st March 1985" and "1st April 1986" in all places where they occur there shall be substituted respectively "31st March 1987" and "1st April 1987".

Amendments having effect on and from 1st September 1987

Lecturer Grade

7. For "lecturer grade II" in all places where it occurs there shall be substituted "lecturer grade".

Allowances

- **8.**—(1) In regulation 10(1) and (2) (allowances for head of department) for "£1,584" and "£1,392" there shall be substituted respectively "£1,746" and "£1,533".
- (2) In regulation 11 (allowances for principal lecturers) for "31st March 1987", "5%" and "1st April 1987" there shall be substituted respectively "31st August 1987", "15·7% based on the levels of allowance payable on 1st April 1986" and "1st September 1987".

Salary scales

- **9.** In paragraphs 1, 7 and 8 of Schedule I for the existing tables of salary scales there shall be substituted the respective tables of salary scales set out in Annex B of this amendment.
- 10. In paragraph 4(1)(b) of Schedule I for "incremental point 1" there shall be substituted "incremental point (a)".

Entry to salary scales

11. In Schedule II (Entry to Scales of Salaries) for "31st March 1987" and "1st April 1987" in all places where they occur there shall be substituted respectively "31st August 1987" and "1st September 1987".

Transfer to revised salary scales

12. For Part I of Schedule II there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in Annex D of this amendment.

Amendments having effect on and from 1st April 1988

Starting pay

13. In Part II of Schedule II "1½ increments" shall be deleted and "an amount equal to one increment" substituted in all places where it occurs.

Amendments having effect on and from 1st July 1988

Allowances

- **14.**—(1) In regulation 10(1) and (2) (allowances for head of department) for "£1,746" and "£1,533" there shall be substituted respectively "£1,851" and "£1,626".
- (2) In regulation 11 (allowances for principal lecturers) for "31st August 1987", "15·7% based on the levels of allowance payable on 1st April 1986" and "1st September 1987" there shall be substituted respectively "30th June 1988", "6%" and "1st July 1988".

Salary scales

15. In paragraphs 1, 7 and 8 of Schedule I for the existing tables of salary scales there shall be substituted the respective tables of salary scales set out in Annex C of this amendment.

Entry to salary scales

16. In Schedule II (Entry to Scales of Salaries) for "31st August 1987" and "1st September 1987" in all places where they occur there shall be substituted respectively "30th June 1988" and "1st July 1988".

Transfer to revised salary scales

17. For Part I of Schedule II there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in Annex E of this amendment.

Regulation 12

ENTRY TO SCALES OF SALARIES APPLICABLE FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER 1987

Part I

TRANSFER TO REVISED SCALES OF SALARIES

- 1.—(1) Where a lecturer is due an increment on 1st September 1987 the increment shall be paid on the scale in operation at 31st August 1987.
- (2) A lecturer who is paid on any scale in force up to 31st August 1987 and who continues on the corresponding scale applicable on and from 1st September 1987 shall be transferred, subject to the provision in paragraph 1(1), to that scale at the same incremental point.
- .(3) A vice-principal or principal shall be paid on and from 1st September 1987 a salary in the appropriate range corresponding to that in the range on which he was paid on 31st August 1987.

ANNEX E

SCHEDULE II

Regulation 17

ENTRY TO SCALES OF SALARIES APPLICABLE FROM 1ST JULY 1988

PART I

TRANSFER TO REVISED SCALES OF SALARIES

- 1.—(1) A lecturer who is paid on any scale in force up to 30th June 1988 and who continues on the corresponding scale applicable on and from 1st July 1988 shall be transferred to that scale at the same incremental point.
- (2) A vice-principal or principal shall be paid on and from 1st July 1988 a salary in the appropriate range corresponding to that in the range on which he was paid on 30th June 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations.)

These regulations amend the Colleges of Education Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981.

The detailed provisions include:

- (a) revised scales of salaries based on a 5% increase from 1st April 1987 Annex A;
- (b) further enhancement of scales effective from 1st September 1987 Annex B;
- (c) further revised scales based on a 6% increase from 1st July 1988 Annex C;
- (d) commensurate revisions of certain allowances for all 3 stages of salaries increases;
- (e) the replacement of lecturer grade II by lecturer grade effective from 1st September 1987 regulation 7;
- (f) the amendment of the definition of salary to include promotion allowances effective from 1st October 1987 regulation 3;
- (g) revised arrangements for the transfer of lecturers to the new scales which take effect on 1st September 1987 and 1st July 1988 — Annex D and Annex E.

Where the regulations have retrospective effect this is by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
