Asbestos (Licensing) (Fees Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989

Made 31st July 1989 Coming into operation 2nd October 1989

The Department of Agriculture, the Department of Economic Development and the Department of the Environment acting jointly as the Department concerned(a) in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 40(2) and (4) of the Health and Safety at Work (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(b) and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, after consultation in accordance with Article 46(1) of that Order with the Health and Safety Agency for Northern Ireland and such other bodies as appear to them to be appropriate, hereby make the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulatons may be cited as the Asbestos (Licensing) (Fees Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 2nd October 1989.

Amendment of the Asbestos (Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984

- 2. For paragraph (6) of regulation 4 of the Asbestos (Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984(c) there shall be substituted—
 - "(6) A fee of £150 shall be payable by the applicant to the Department on each application being made for a licence under this regulation, but where the application is for a licence to follow a previous licence without any gap in time the fee shall be £75.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Asbestos (Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984 and increase the fees payable to the Department of Economic Development by an applicant for a licence under regulation 4 of those Regulations for work with asbestos insulation or asbestos coating.

The fee payable on each application for a licence is increased from £100 to £150 except that in the case of an application for a licence to follow a previous licence without any gap in time the fee payable is increased from £50 to £75 (regulation 2).
