(Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990**

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) of the Human Organ Transplants (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a), paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the Human Organ Transplants (1989 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990.

*Appointed day*

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of Article 4(1) of the Human Organ Transplants (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 shall be 3rd December 1990.

This Order appoints 3rd December 1990 as the day for coming into operation of Article 4(1) of the Human Organ Transplants (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 which prohibits the transplant of organs from, and to, living persons who are not genetically related.
