The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 69(1) and (2) and $(3)(\mathbf{a})$, $70(1)(b)(\mathbf{b})$ and 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(c), and by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(d) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation in accordance with Article 69(5)(a) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(c) hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 23rd December 1991 and shall have effect on and from 1st December 1991.

Amendment of Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987

2. The Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(e) shall be amended as provided in regulations 3 to 11.

3. For the table in regulation 7 (salary of principals) there shall be substituted the following table---

Regulations 9, 10 and 22

TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR TEACHERS IN SERVICE ON 30th November 1991

1. A teacher, other than a principal or vice-principal, who on 1st December 1991 was, and had immediately before that date been, in teaching service in a grant-aided school or as a peripatetic or supply teacher, shall from that date be placed on the standard scale at the point on the scale corresponding to that on which he would have received salary had the scale in operation on 30th November 1991 continued to apply.

2.—(1) Subject to regulation 10(6) and (7) a teacher who was on 30th November 1991 in receipt of a promotion allowance payable under regulation 10 as it had effect on 30th November 1991 shall from 1st December 1991 be paid the corresponding promotion allowance set out in regulation 10(1) except that in the case of an allowance payable under regulation 10(4)(a) or (b) this sub-paragraph shall apply only so long as the teacher holds the same post.

(2) Subject to sub-paragraph (3) a teacher who was on 30th November 1991 in receipt of a promotion allowance under paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 3 to the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 as it had effect on 30th November 1991 shall be paid the corresponding promotion allowance set out in regulation 10(1), unless it is superseded by an allowance of an equal or greater amount payable under regulation 10 or regulation 11.

(3) Sub-paragraph (2) shall apply only so long as the teacher holds the same post."

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987, as amended, and give effect from 1st December 1991 to a further increase of 5.25% (on rates as at 31st March 1991) in salaries for principals and vice-principals, together with a further increase of 2% (on rates as at 31st March 1991) in salaries, and an increase of 30% in promotion allowances, for other teachers in primary, secondary and special schools and for peripatetic and supply teachers.

Revised scales and rates of salary for principals, vice-principals and for other full-time qualified teachers are set out in regulations 3 to 5.

Revised rates of promotion allowances are set out in regulation 6.

Revised hourly rates of pay for certain part-time teachers are set out in regulation 8.

Regulation 9 sets out the revised minimum rate of salary for full-time unqualified teachers.

Regulations 10 and 11 and the Schedule detail the transitional arrangements for teachers in service on 30th November 1991.

These Regulations have retrospective effect by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
