Ireland) Order 1981(a) and the powers conferred by section 56(1), (2) and (5) of the Finance Act 1973(b) and with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1992.

Interpretation

- 2.—(1) In these Regulations—
- "applicant" means an applicant for the issue of a type approval certificate or authorisation for a vehicle or vehicle part for the purpose of a Community Instrument, an applicant for the issue of a type approval certificate or Department's approval certificate for a vehicle or vehicle part for the purpose of the Northern Ireland type approval scheme;
- "approval mark" means a marking designated as an approval mark by the Motor Vehicles (Designation of Approval Marks) Regulations 1979(d);
- "approval requirements" means—
 - (a) the requirements for examination and approval as regards the type approval requirements specified in—
 - (i) a Community Instrument, and
 - (ii) Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Regulations; or
 - (b) the requirements for examination and marking authorisation relating to a marking designated as an approval mark;
- "approved premises" means premises established or approved by the Department for the examination of vehicles or vehicle parts for the purposes of the Northern Ireland type approval scheme or for the purpose of a Community Instrument or ECE Regulation;
- "authorisation" means an authorisation in writing given by the Department for the application of an approval mark to a vehicle or vehicle part;
- "Community Instrument" means a Council Regulation, a Council or Commission Directive being a Regulation or Directive mentioned in column 2(b) of Schedule 1 or in an item in a Schedule to the Northern Ireland Regulations or the Type Approval (EEC) Regulations;
- "ECE Regulation" means a Regulation annexed to the Agreement concerning the adoption of uniform conditions of approval for motor vehicle equipment and parts and reciprocal recognition thereof

- concluded at Geneva on 20th March 1958(a) as amended(b) to which the United Kingdom is a party(c);
- "examination" means any examination or test, or series of examinations or tests, carried out on a vehicle or vehicle part to ascertain that in respect of that vehicle or vehicle part approval requirements have been satisfied:
- "the Northern Ireland Regulations" means the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985(d);
- "the Northern Ireland type approval scheme" means the provisions for the type approval of vehicles and vehicle parts contained in the Northern Ireland Regulations:
- "the Order" means the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981;
- "a type approval certificate", "a Department's approval certificate" and an authorisation' include a modified or duplicate type approval certificate, Department's approval certificate or authorisation as the case may be; and
- (2) A reference in these Regulations to a vehicle in category L5 is a reference to a vehicle described as L5 in ECE Regulation 13 of 29th May 1969 and a reference to a vehicle in category M1, M2, M3, N1, N2 or N3 is a reference to a vehicle described respectively as M1, M2, M3, N1, N2 or N3 in Council Directive 70/156/EEC of 6th February 1970(e).
- Fees basic scale for examination of vehicles or parts of vehicles
- 3.—(1) In this regulation any reference to a numbered column is a reference to the column bearing that number in Schedule 1.
- (2) Subject to the subsequent provisions of these Regulations, the fee for an examination in relation to an approval requirement in column 2 is the amount specified in relation to that requirement in column 4.
- (3) Where, in relation to an approval requirement specified in column 2. more than one type of examination or more than one type of vehicle or vehicle part is specified in column 3, the fee is the amount specified in column 4 opposite the examination, vehicle or vehicle part in question.
 - (4) The fees specified—
 - (a) in column 4(a) are prescribed in a case where the examination is to be carried out on approved premises by an officer of the Department or a person appointed by the Department to act on its behalf;

- (b) in column 4(b) are prescribed in a case where the examination is to be carried out at other premises under the supervision of an officer of the Department or a person appointed by the Department to act on its behalf.
- (5) Schedule 5 shall have effect for the purposes of interpreting certain expressions relating to Community Instruments and certain abbreviations used in Schedule 1.

Fees — consecutive examinations

4. Where more than one vehicle or vehicle part of the same type but embodying minor variations is submitted by an applicant with a view to carrying out the examinations consecutively on each item and the case is one where all the examinations can be carried out without setting up the examination apparatus again, the fee to be paid for the carrying out of each examination after the first one is such proportion of the fee prescribed in regulation 3 as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such examination.

Fees — partial examinations

- 5.—(1) Where there has been issued as regards a vehicle or vehicle part—
 - (a) a type approval certificate, or an authorisation, in relation to a Community Instrument; or
 - (b) a type approval certificate, or a Department's approval certificate, in relation to the Northern Ireland type approval scheme,

and in consequence of an alteration in the design specification of the vehicle or vehicle part, either—

- (A) a further examination of the vehicle or vehicle part is needed with a view to the issue of a modified or further certificate, but the alteration is not so extensive as to require that the further examination shall be as complete and exhaustive as the original examination; or
- (B) an applicant requires a modification of a certificate, but the alteration is not so extensive as to require a further examination of the vehicle or vehicle part and can be carried out on an examination of data supplied by the applicant,

the fee for such an examination is such proportion of the fee prescribed in regulation 3 as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such examination.

- (2) Where, in the case of an examination mentioned in regulation 3 or 4 or in paragraph (1)—
 - (a) it has been found impossible to complete the examination satisfactorily; or
 - (b) the vehicle or vehicle part submitted for the examination does not satisfy completely the requirements of the examination,

and, in consequence, a further, but partial, examination of the vehicle or vehicle part is required, the fee to be paid for such further examination is such proportion of the fee prescribed in regulation 3 as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such further partial examination.

(3) Where more than one vehicle or vehicle part of the same type but embodying minor variations is submitted by an applicant and it is unnecessary to submit each individual vehicle or vehicle part to a complete examination the fee to be paid for the partial examination of a particular vehicle or vehicle part is such proportion of the fee prescribed in regulation 3 as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such partial examination.

Fees — final examination of complete vehicle

- 6.—(1) The fee for the final examination of a vehicle to which the Northern Ireland Regulations apply with a view to the issue in respect of that vehicle of a certificate specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 where, before the examination takes place, type approval procedures have been carried out (whether in Northern Ireland or elsewhere) which have determined that in respect of that vehicle all the approval requirements which—
 - (a) are referred to in Schedule 1 to those Regulations;
 - (b) relate to particular parts or aspects of a vehicle; and
 - (c) are applicable to the vehicle,

have been satisfied, is the amount specified in relation thereto in column 3 of Schedule 2.

- (2). Where in the case of an examination of a vehicle mentioned in paragraph (1)—
 - (a) it has been found impossible to complete that examination satisfactorily;
 - (b) the vehicle has been found not to comply in all respects with the relevant approval requirements;
 - (c) the vehicle is one which has been assembled in more than one stage by more than one manufacturer; or
 - (d) a type approval certificate or Department's approval certificate has previously been issued in respect of the model of the vehicle but the vehicle incorporates certain changes in detail not covered by that certificate.

and, in consequence, a further, but partial, examination of the vehicle is required before the relevant document can properly be issued in respect of it, the fee for that partial examination shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 2 as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such partial examination.

Fees — avoidance of duplication

7. Where the examination of a vehicle or vehicle part for the purposes of a Community Instrument is carried out at the same time as the examination of that vehicle or vehicle part for the purposes of the Northern Ireland type approval scheme, then, insofar as one and the same operation or series of operations serves for both examinations, the fee payable shall be the fee for only one examination.

Fees — issue of documents

- 8.—(1) The fee for the issue of a document of a type specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 (being a document relating to a vehicle part) is the amount specified in relation thereto in column 3 of Schedule 3.
- (2) The fee for the issue of a document specified in column 1 of Schedule 4 (being a document relating to a vehicle to which the Northern Ireland Regulations apply) is the amount specified in relation thereto in column 3 of Schedule 4

Fees — visits outside the United Kingdom

- 9.—(1) Where, in connection with the carrying out, or supervision, of an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part in relation to the issue of a type approval certificate or authorisation for the purpose of a Community Instrument, or in relation to a type approval certificate or Department's approval certificate for the purpose of the Northern Ireland type approval scheme, a visit to a place outside the United Kingdom is made, or is arranged to be made, by one or more persons acting for or on behalf of the Department, then in addition to the fees prescribed above, there shall be paid by the applicant on demand by or on behalf of the Department a further fee equal to the total of—
 - (a) the travelling and subsistence expenses reasonably incurred or expected to be incurred otherwise than on land in the United Kingdom by each person so acting in relation to the examination (including expenses outstanding after the cancellation of any travelling or subsistence arrangements which result from the withdrawal of the application); and
 - (b) the whole, or such proportion as is reasonably attributable to the examination, of a sum of £54 for each hour spent or expected to be spent by each person so acting whilst travelling otherwise than on land in the United Kingdom wholly or partly in relation to the examination.
 - (2) If—
 - (a) payments have been made in accordance with paragraph (1) in respect of travelling and subsistence expenses expected to be incurred, or in respect of time expected to be spent in travelling; and
 - (b) the amount of travelling and subsistence expenses actually incurred or the time actually spent travelling in consequence of the application is greater or less than was estimated,

the fee payable under paragraph (1) shall be re-calculated in accordance with that paragraph by reference to the actual travelling and subsistence expenses incurred and the actual time spent in travelling, and the difference shall be paid by, or as the case may be, refunded, to the applicant.

Payment of fees

10.—(1) The fee for an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part in connection with the issue of a type approval certificate or authorisation for the purpose of a Community Instrument shall be paid when the application is made for the issue of the type approval certificate or authorisation for the vehicle or vehicle part in question.

- (2) The fee for an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part in connection with the issue of a type approval certificate or a Department's approval certificate for the purposes of the Northern Ireland type approval scheme shall be paid when the applicant is notified by the Department, in accordance with the provisions of the Northern Ireland Regulations, of the fee payable.
 - (3) If—
 - (a) payments have been made in accordance with paragraph (1) in respect of travelling and subsistence expenses expected to be incurred, or in respect of time expected to be spent in travelling; and
 - (b) the amount of travelling and subsistence expenses actually incurred or the time actually spent travelling in consequence of the application is greater or less than was estimated,

the fee payable under paragraph (1) shall be re-calculated in accordance with that paragraph by reference to the actual travelling and subsistence expenses incurred and the actual time spent in travelling, and the difference shall be paid by, or as the case may be, refunded, to the applicant.

- (4) The fee for the issue of a document specified in Schedule 3 or 4 shall be paid—
 - (a) in a case where the examination of a vehicle or vehicle part for which a fee is payable is required before the document is issued, when the applicant is notified of the result of the examination; and
 - (b) in any other case, when the application is made for the issue of the document.

Fees on withdrawals and cancellations

- 11.—(1) Subject to regulation 12, where an applicant—
- (a) after he has been notified of the time and place for the examination withdraws his application; or
- (b) does not submit the vehicle or vehicle part for the examination at the appointed time and place,

he shall be liable to pay a cancellation fee to cover the abortive work involved in dealing with the application and making arrangements for the examination.

- (2) In the case of an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part to which a fee specified in Schedule 1 applies, the cancellation fee shall be—
 - (a) £97, if the Department is notified of the withdrawal or of the intention not to submit the vehicle or vehicle part for the examination not less than 7 days before the date fixed for the examination, or
 - (b) in any other case—
 - (i) where the fee is specified in column 4(a) of Schedule 1, a quarter of that fee plus any wasted expenses reasonably incurred by the Department in the provision of any facility for the particular examination; or
 - (ii) where the fee is specified in column 4(b) of Schedule 1, half of that fee or £215 if that is less.
- (3) In the case of a further or partial examination of a vehicle or vehicle part in the circumstances described in regulation 5, the cancellation fee shall

be such proportion of the fee as is commensurate with the work involved in carrying out such examination.

- (4) In the case of an examination of a vehicle to which a fee specified in Schedule 2 applies, the cancellation fee shall be—
 - (a) £95, if the Department is notified of the withdrawal or of the intention not to submit the vehicle for examination not less than 14 days before the date fixed for the examination, or
 - (b) £280 in any other case.
- (5) Any cancellation fee for which an applicant is liable in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this regulation shall be provided—
 - (a) in a case where the applicant has paid the fee prescribed by these Regulations for the examination in question, by the Department retaining the said cancellation fee from the fee which has been paid; or
 - (b) in any other case, by the applicant paying the said cancellation fee to the Department within 14 days of the issue by the Department of a request for such payment.
- (6) An applicant who is liable for a cancellation fee under this regulation in respect of an application shall also be liable for any fee payable under regulation 9, but all other fees under these Regulations in respect of the application shall be reduced to nil (the balance of any sums paid in respect of the application being refundable).

Submission of alternative vehicle or vehicle part for examination

12. Where an applicant does not wish, or is unable, to submit the vehicle or vehicle part in respect of which the application was made, for examination at the time and place appointed, but is able to submit for examination at that time and place some other vehicle or vehicle part which can conveniently be fitted into the programme of examinations being carried out at that place and in respect of which he has made an application, he shall be entitled, subject to any adjustment by way of refund or additional payment so as to secure that the appropriate fee is paid for the examination which actually takes place, to have the sum which he originally paid applied in payment of the fee for that examination without being liable to pay a cancellation fee under regulation 11(1), but in that event he shall pay the appropriate fee prescribed by these Regulations when applying for a new appointment for the examination which he originally sought.

Revocation

13. The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990(a) are revoked.

- 1. These Regulations revoke and replace with amendments the provisions of Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990.
- 2. The principal changes relate to the fee amounts in Schedules 1-4. The change to the fees contained in these Regulations is an overall increase of approximately 28%, however some fees remain unchanged and some are reduced.
- 3. In addition to changes to fee amounts, the introduction of new Community Instruments means that—
 - (1) certain new fees relating to reflex reflecting devices, directional indicators, special warning lights, rear view mirrors, rear registration plates, unleaded fuel capability, fuel input orifice headlamps, strenth of seats and anchorages for public service vehicles, mechanical couplings and tyres have been added to Schedule 1; and
 - (2) reference to those, as alternatives to existing Community Instruments in relation to headlamps, directional indicators, side, rear, or stop lamps, reversing lamps, parking lamps, rear view mirrors, petrol engine exhaust emissions, diesel engine gaseous emissions, engine power, fuel consumption, seat belts, seat belt anchorages, seat belt installation, steering, forward field of vision, seats and anchorages and head restraints appear for the first time.
- 4. Copies of the Community Instruments referred to in these Regulations may be obtained from Her Majesty's Stationery Office.
