**Diseases of Animals (Animal Protein) (No. 2)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992**

Made 21st February 1992

Coming into operation 16th March 1992

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(3), 5(1), 19, 44 and 60(1) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Animal Protein) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 16th March 1992.

Amendment of the Diseases of Animals (Animal Protein) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989

2. The Diseases of Animals (Animal Protein) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989(b) shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in Article 3(1) after the definition of “approved disinfectant” there shall be inserted the following definition—

“ “business number” means a number allocated by the Department to a person who is engaged in the business of removing, holding or processing animal protein”;

(b) after Article 5(8) there shall be inserted the following subparagraph:—

“(9) A person who is engaged in the business of removing animal protein shall quote his business number in all literature connected in any way with his business and on request to interested parties.”;

(c) Article 13 shall be renumbered as Article 13.—(1) and after that paragraph there shall be inserted the following paragraphs—

“(2) A person who is engaged in the business of removing animal protein, whether processed or unprocessed, from any premises shall in respect of each consignment—

- (a) make a record of—
- (i) the date of removal of the consignment;
 - (ii) the quantity and type of animal protein;
 - (iii) the address of the premises of origin;
 - (iv) the address of the premises of destination.
- (3) The owner or person in charge of any premises used for the collection or holding of animal protein shall—
- (a) make a record of—
- (i) the address of any premises from which animal protein is received;
 - (ii) the business number of any person from whom he receives animal protein where such a person is engaged in the business of removing animal protein;
 - (iii) the address of any premises to which animal protein is dispatched.
- (4) Any person required to keep a record as described in paragraph (2) or (3) shall—
- (a) retain such a record for a period of 12 months from the date of receipt of the animal protein or, as the case may be, removal or despatch of the animal protein; and
 - (b) produce such a record to an inspector on demand being made by him at any reasonable time during that period of 12 months and allow him to take a copy of it or an extract from it.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Diseases of Animals (Animal Protein) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989. It requires that any person engaged in the business of removing animal protein shall quote a business number allocated to him by the Department of Agriculture in any literature connected with his business and on request to interested parties.

The Order also requires removers of animal protein and the owner or person in charge of any premises used for the collection and holding of animal protein to keep records and retain them for a period of 12 months. These records shall be produced to an inspector on demand during that period of retention.
