**The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1993**

Made 29th September 1993

Coming into operation 18th October 1993

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(2) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 18th October 1993.

(2) In this Order “commissioner for oaths” includes a solicitor exercising the powers of a commissioner for oaths under Article 78 of the Solicitors (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(b).

Increase in fees

2. The following fees (inclusive of value added tax where payable) shall be charged by commissioners for oaths:—

For taking an affidavit, declaration or affirmation: for each person making the same £5·00

And, in addition: for each exhibit therein referred to and required to be marked or for each schedule required to be marked £2·00

Revocation

3. The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988(c) is hereby revoked, save as to any fee due or payable before the commencement of this Order.
