**The Social Security (Severe Disablement Allowance)
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1993**

Amendment of the Social Security (Severe Disablement Allowance) Regulations

2. In regulation 19 of the Social Security (Severe Disablement Allowance) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984⁽¹⁾ (persons formerly entitled to non-contributory invalidity pension) after paragraph (1) there shall be inserted the following paragraph—

“(1A) A woman who—

- (a) would have been entitled to a non-contributory invalidity pension immediately before 29th November 1984 but for the requirement that she be incapable of performing normal household duties (whether or not she made a claim for that pension); and
- (b) has been continuously incapable of work since that date,

shall be entitled to a severe disablement allowance, whether or not she is disabled for the purposes of section 68 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽²⁾ and whether or not she has attained the age referred to in subsection (4)(d) of that section, if she satisfies the other requirements for entitlement to that allowance.”.
