The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) $1970(\mathbf{a})$, read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) $1962(\mathbf{b})$, and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, operation and effect

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1995 and shall come into operation on 24th November 1995 but shall have effect on and after 1st April 1995.

Removal allowance

2. In regulation 38(6) of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c) for the words "£1,290" there shall be substituted the words "£1,353".
